Welcome to Fort McCoy!

Requests for unit fund AT/ECT dividends should be submitted to email above **within three (3) days after arrival and no less than 7 calendar days prior to event** and include the following:

1. **A current fund custodian appointment memo.** The unit's commanding officer must sign this memo.
2. **The purchase request.** The unit fund custodian must sign this form.
3. **The request for payment.** The unit fund custodian must sign this form.
4. **The unit's alpha roster with Group or Individual Order numbers.** No social security numbers.
 - *The request form must include the name and telephone number of the point of contact. (Fort McCoy phone number or a cell phone while training at Fort McCoy)*
 - *Allow at least two (2) working days for the request to be processed.*
 - *Money will be used for the collective benefit of all members during MWR recreational activities.*
 - *Expending Unit Funds is limited to MWR programs. A request for exception of expending Unit Funds elsewhere may be submitted to the Director, DFMWR.*
 - *Records of expenditures will be maintained by the unit.*
 - **Only the unit fund custodian can pick up payments.** Signature and Identification (ID) is required for payment.
 - *The receipt and any unused funds must be returned within 48 hours of receiving the funds, weekends are excluded. You may email the receipt to unit funds email if all funds have been used.*

Each unit will receive \$1.00 per a Soldier for 2 weeks of AT/ECT training.
