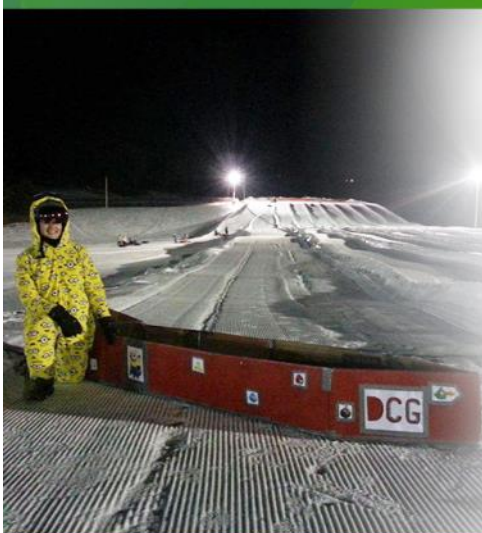
WHITETAIL RIDGE SKI AREA
