

DID YOU KNOW?

Military Spouse State Licensure and Certification Costs Reimbursement: Army Directive 2019-18, retroactively effective 12 December 2017, provides guidance for reimbursement of up to \$500 in Military Spouse state licensure and certification costs arising from a PCS move from one state to another, and the movement of the Soldier's dependents is authorized as part of the reassignment. Additionally, HQs, Army Emergency Relief has provided guidance for AER assistance for any licensure and certification costs above \$500, not to exceed \$2500.
