AFAP Issue Criteria

- 1. Issue Scope is a minimum of three sentences.
- 2. Issue Scope is a maximum of ten sentences.
- 3. Issue is within Department of the Army tasking authority to resolve.
- 4. Issue identifies a single measurable end product.
- 5. Issue identifies a specific demographic group impacted.
- 6. Issue has a maximum of one recommendation.
- 7. Issue addresses one topic.
- 8. Issue requires a single functional proponent for resolution.
- 9. Issue recommendation does not duplicate existing programs, services, policies or legislation introduced within the past three years to the garrison's knowledge.
- 10. Issue does not duplicate an active HQDA AFAP issue or a HQDA AFAP issue that closed in the past three years.
