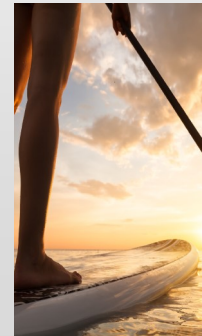

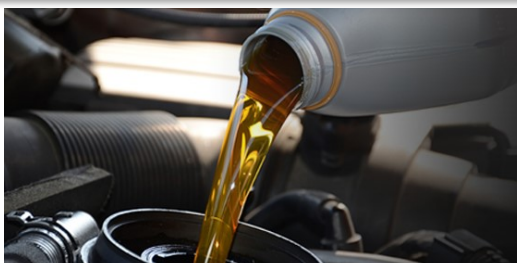

An exceptional Family Member (EFM) is an active duty family member (adult or child) with any physical, emotional, developmental or intellectual disorder that requires special treatment, therapy, education, training or counseling.
